SMF Accepting Reasonable Closed Bid Offers — N80555

Your SMF Board of Directors are accepting "Reasonable Closed Bid Offers" for the purchase of Swift N80555, Serial #58.

The opening bid date is 6/22/2022. The airframe, engine and propeller have sustained damage as the result of a take-off accident.

Unfortunately, an investigation into the aircraft's modifications over the years was launched by a third party thereby resulting in the FAA grounding the aircraft due to limited supporting documentation for the flush riveting and the currently installed auxiliary fuel tanks in the wings. At the time of the accident and currently, the aircraft has a Continental I.O.-360 with 384 hours SMOH, a Hartzell propeller, Nagel bubble canopy, sticks and a retractable tailwheel. Inspection of the aircraft will be available Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. - 5 p.m. at the Swift Museum Foundation Headquarters on the McMinn County Airport KMMI. Please contact Headquarters for an appointment time if you wish to inspect the aircraft.

All offers will be considered on 7/22/2022; if the highest offer is not acceptable to your SMF Board of Directors, consideration will be given to explore other options.

If a successful bid is selected on **7/22/2022**, a written "Hold Harmless" agreement releasing the SMF from any past or future liabilities with regards to the purchase of N80555 and its related parts will be signed and notarized by the purchaser.

FYI—The following information is from EAA EAA - Vintage Aircraft Association

EAA AirVenture Oshkosh is fast approaching, and we're looking forward to welcoming well over 1,000 pilots and their airplanes to parking in Vintage! A few guidelines to keep in mind:

• To qualify for parking in Vintage, your aircraft must have been constructed prior to December 31, 1970

• Parking east of Wittman Road is first come, first served. If you want to park as a group of two or more air planes, you must arrive together.

• Staking out and reserving aircraft parking or camping spots east of Wittman Road is prohibited. Stakes, tiedowns, banners, ribbons, ropes, and credentials will be removed if an aircraft is not occupying that space. Exceptions include aircraft temporarily at Aircraft Repair or Showcase Display. Thank you for your cooperation!
